

## APPLY NOW FOR THE NEW PROVIDER RELIEF FUND

It was recently announced by The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) that \$20 billion in new funding will be available for providers on the front-lines of the COVID-19 pandemic. [Read the full press release here.](#)

Under this Phase 3 General Distribution allocation, providers that have already received [Provider Relief Fund](#) payments will be invited to apply for additional funding that considers financial losses and changes in operating expenses caused by COVID-19.

Providers who were previously ineligible may now qualify. This includes:

- Providers who previously received, rejected or accepted a General Distribution Provider Relief Fund payment. Providers that have already received payments of approximately 2% of annual revenue from patient care may submit more information to become eligible for an additional payment.
- Behavioral Health providers, including those that previously received funding and new providers.
- Healthcare providers that began practicing January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020. This includes Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, dentists, assisted living facilities and behavioral health providers.
